Active Travel Challenge

We are coming to the end of our ten day Active Travel Challenge. The children have been recording their active journeys in class, as well as scooting to school. Class 1 were the winners of the challenge, with a fantastic 22 children scooting to school, so they can scoot and store on Thursday 19th. Class 2 came second with 14, so they can scoot on Friday 20th.

We plan to double up from now on, so that two classes per day can continue to come to school on their scooters. This is based on the number who scooted during the trial period.
