**Re: Litter Pick**

We have been asked by Nicki Goodwin, an Ashwood school Governor from the High Street Centre, if 30 of our Ashwood children would like to take part in a litter pick on the afternoon of Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April, leaving school at 1:00pm and returning at 3:00pm. We will be doing our bit for the environment; improving the appearance of the local area; and serving our community. Neal and Nicky have already been out litter picking with groups from other local schools who collected almost 20 bags of rubbish each.....so there's certainly a job to be done.

All the relevant risk assessments are in place and we will be more than adequately covered with the ratio of adults to children, including Ashwood staff. The children will be fully briefed before setting off from school. We have arranged for the library to put some refreshments on for the children once they've finished.

School will provide 'high vis' jackets for the children to wear and 'litter pickers', so that they don't actually touch anything. If your child has wellies, it might be worth bringing these to school to wear and also a pair of gloves. We are going to be 'litter-picking' in a little wooded area near to the library.
