Dear parents/carers

I know Christmas this year will be very different from the ones we are used to in school. I want to try and give the children something to celebrate and a time with their friends. The following are things that I think we can do to try and bring some Christmas cheer!

Christmas cards

Children will be allowed to bring Christmas Cards in for the friends **in their class**. We will ask children to bring their cards in throughout the week, so they can be quarantined and given out on a Monday after a weekend.

Christmas parties

Children will have Christmas parties in their classrooms. School will provide savoury snacks, drinks and games. Each class will contact parents to let them know the date and time of their class party and if they want children to bring anything in. Children will be able to come to school in party clothes on that day!

Christmas concerts

Unfortunately we are not going to be able to hold any large gatherings so there won't be a nativity or carol concert this year.

We would like to invite parents into the large playground on the following days to see children singing carols, reading poems or performing little plays. Two people from each family only please. You will be required to wear a mask, stand with people from your own household only and stay 2metres apart from others. You will be asked to stand on a 'spot' to maintain social distancing. Please try not to bring young children with you. If you do need to bring them due to child care reasons they will count as the 2nd person. If it rains we will be unable to go ahead with this and we will video the children instead and share the video via dojo or email.
