Indoor Climbing Activity – Year 6

Dear Parent/Carer,

On Friday 4th December, your child will be taking part in a climbing activity at Clifton Community School Campus. The trip will be led by Miss Jenkinson, accompanied by Miss Hinchliffe. All local authority risk assessments have been completed and children will be fitted with a safety harness which will be checked by a qualified instructor. All activities are suitable for non-climbers. The children will be travelling by Rawmarsh Community School mini-bus. The coach will depart school at 12.00pm and return around 2.30pm. The children will need a packed lunch on this day and will eat before they go on the visit.

This is an indoor activity and children will be required to bring:

- Sensible clothing suitable for the activity. Tracksuit, leggings, t shirt or normal P.E. kit
- Trainers (secure footwear no pumps)

Outings are enjoyable and a very valuable educational experience and we thank you for your support.

School expects children to behave in an appropriate, sensible manner and to follow the school code of conduct at all times. We reserve the right to refuse access to the visit for children who do not meet the acceptable criteria. If you are happy for your son/daughter to go on the visit, then please complete the slip attached and return it to school.

Covid-19

WPT climbing sessions will only be taking place in bubble groups for individual schools. A distance of 2 metres will be maintained wherever possible; however, this might be impractical during group belaying therefore the '1 metre plus' principle will be applied.

The BMC states that using hand sanitiser is the most important single thing one can do when climbing on an indoor wall to prevent transmission following contact with a contaminated hold or indeed any other surface. Therefore, on arrival at the wall, all children will be asked to apply hand sanitiser to avoid any potential contamination of the wall or equipment. All karabiners, harnesses and belay devices will be cleaned after each session with groups using separate entrances and exits on arrival and departure. The Sports Hall will also be well ventilated, with 4 sets of external doors open throughout.

If there is an emergency and it is important for you to contact your child during the visit, please contact school on 01709 710847. The trip leader will then be contacted and your child informed. If you have any questions, please contact the class teacher.
