Students will require a packed lunch and drink.

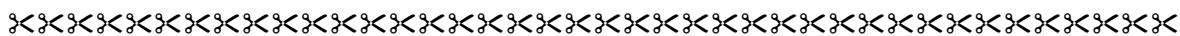
Students will be expected to wear uniform and have suitable footwear and outdoor clothing.
