CLASS NEWS

English: Our English learning will be linked to, and driven by, our class text *Goodnight Mr Tom* by Michelle Magorian. This text will provide stimulus for other areas of the curriculum, including Art and History. In the first few weeks of the Autumn term, pupils will create a biography and diary entry.

In Year 6, we will ensure that we teach the Year 6 spelling rules as well as embed spelling rules previously taught. Each week, pupils will be given a set of spellings to learn and will be tested on Friday.

Maths: Our maths learning journey this half term will guide use through the world of place value, the four operations and fractions. Each morning, we will work on arithmetic questions ensuring pupils are secure with all strands of the curriculum. In our maths lessons, we will develop pupil's fluency and reasoning skills.

As well as the mathematical knowledge, during each lesson, we will be teaching the pupils specific tips to help support them in preparation for the SATs.
