CLASS NEWS

English: Our English learning will continue from last term, where we had begun to focus on parts of a narrative. We will commence the term writing our own narratives, using our knowledge on character and setting description. In addition, this will start to explore our use of dialogue.

We will then move on to looking at letters, both formal and informal. This will be based around our debating skills and looking at how persuasive we can be in our writing.

Maths: Our maths learning journey this half term will commence with a whistle stop tour on time. We will focus on how we measure time and convert.

We will then move on to looking at shape, before focusing on multiplication and division for the remaining half term. This is really important for year 4, as this helps us prepare for our multiplication test we carry out in June 2023. We will look at times table facts, learn ways to recite them, and will use TT Rockstars to support this.


