A big shout out to all the team at Ashwood for continuing to strive for the very best for each and every child.

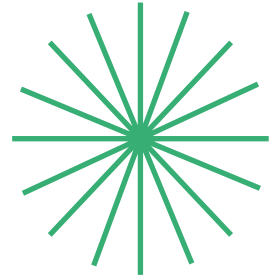
