Week 2	Move to Spring 2 - review Phase 3: ai ee igh oo oo ar or ur oo ow oi ear Reassess Spring 1 at the end of the week.
Week 3	Spring 2 - Review Phase 3: er air words with double letters longer words
Week 4	Spring 2 - Words with two or more digraphs
Week 5	Spring 2 - longer words words ending in -ing compound words
Week 6	Spring 2 - Longer words, words with s in the middle /z/ s, words ending -s, words with -es at end /z/

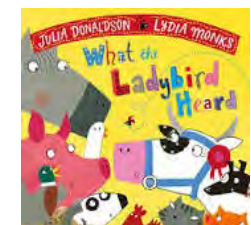
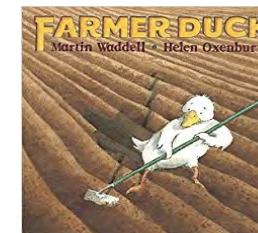
