## Phonics



This term we will be reviewing the phonemes from last term Consolidating all of phase 3 and begin phase 4.

In Phase 4, children don't learn any new sounds. Instead, they practice blending the sounds they already know into longer, more complex words (like **tent**, **frog**, and **jump**). They will also learn to read a new set of "tricky words"—common words that cannot be easily sounded out yet, such as *said*, *have*, *like*, and *some*.

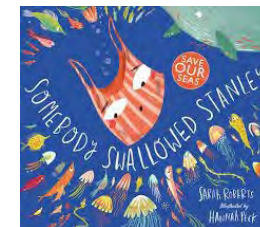
